ORDINANCE NO. 268

AMENDMENT TO ORDINANCE NO. 259 SETTING TIMES FIREWORKS CAN BE SOLD AND DISCHARGED IN THE CITY OF CARLISLE DECLARING AN EMERGENCY AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Section 2-2. Exemptions

Exemptions of Ordinance No. 259 is amended as follows:

- (E) Fireworks may only be discharged between June 27th and July 4th and ending on July 4th at 12:00 midnight. Fireworks may not be discharged from public streets, and all debris which lands on public property or the private property of another must be promptly removed.
- (K) Fireworks may only be sold within the city limits from June 27^{th} to July 4^{th} at 12:00 midnight.

All other sections of Ordinance No. 259 not specifically amended herein shall remain in full force and effect.

This amendment is hereby ascertained to be necessary for the public welfare, safety, comfort, and convenience of the inhabitants of the City of Carlisle, an emergency is hereby declared, and this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval.
